Always replace TPMS seals during tire service

According to car factory recommendations, all Tire Pressure Monitoring System seals must be replaced every time a tire is removed from the rim to prevent loss of tire pressure. These seals include:

- Sealing cap
- Valve stem nut
- Rubber grommet
- Nickel-plated valve core

TPMS detects tire under-inflation of 25 percent or more. Properly inflated tires:

- Improve fuel economy
- Decrease tire wear
- Improve vehicle handling
- Reduce braking distances
- Lower the risk of hydroplaning
